Matrix of Pending Recycling and Product Take-back Legislation in the USA

As state legislatures are starting to adjourn, e-waste legislation proposed in Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado, Georgia, Hawaii, Iowa, Minnesota, Vermont and Washington will no longer receive consideration this year. Texas SB329 for televisions was approved by the House and Senate and is expected to be signed by the Governor. Similarly, Illinois SB2106 which will significantly amend IL's existing e-waste law is expected to pass this year.

Maine LD981 (HB725) was enacted into law June 8, 2011; LD981 amends ME's existing e-waste law by expanding the scope of covered entities and instituting a tiered fee structure.
